APP for the State.

The petitioners seek bail in connection with Kalyanpur P.S. Case no. 18 of 2018 registered under Sections 414 of I.P.C. and Sections 30(a) 33 of Bihar Prohibition & Excise Act-2016.

32 lts. of illicit liquor is said to have been recovered from joint possession of the petitioners.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioners that no incriminating article has been recovered from conscious physical possession of the petitioners. They have no concern with the seized liquor. They have been falsely implicated in the



case at the instance of their enemy by planting the aforesaid recovery from their possession. They have no criminal antecedent. They have been languishing in custody since 25.02.2018.

In the facts and circumstances of the case, the above named petitioners are directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, East Champaran, Motihari in connection with Kalyanpur P.S. Case no. 18 of 2018.
