2 19-04-2018 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the
learned APP for the State.

Petitioner, already in custody, seeks bail in connection
with Imadpur PS Case No.20 of 2016, registered under Sections
365 and 366/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Allegation in brief is that the petitioner kidnapped the
married daughter of the informant.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
daughter of the informant was an adult lady and it is not a case
of kidnapping rather elopement as reflected from her statement
recorded under Section 164 Cr.P.C. admitting the fact of
marrying with the petitioner and living together and at best it
may be a case of adultery.

Having considered the aforesaid facts and



circumstances, petitioner Guddu Upadhaya @ Abhishekh Upadhaya is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Judicial Magistrate-1, Bhojpur at Ara in connection with Imadpur PS Case No.20 of 2016.
