2 17-05-2018 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

The petitioner has been in custody since 22.01.2018
in connection with Digha P.S. Case No. 47 of 2018 registered for
the offences punishable under Sections 392/34 of the Indian Penal
Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that
though not named in the First Information Report, his name has
surfaced in the confessional statement made before the police by
one Sunny Kumar @ Vivek Kumar. It is further submitted that the
looted mobile phone of the informant has been recovered from the
possession of the said Sunny Kumar and not this petitioner.

Considering aforementioned facts and circumstances,
and that the confessional statement made before the police by a



co-accused has no evidentiary value, let the petitioner above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned S.D.J.M., Patna, in connection with Digha P.S. Case No. 47 of 2018.
