2 16-05-2018 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

The petitioner has been in custody since 22.05.2017
in connection with Tajpur P.S. Case No. 237/2012 registered for
the offences punishable under Sections 384/307/365/440/34 of the
Indian Penal Code and Section 34 of the Explosive Substance Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
allegation against the petitioner is that he along with others
exploded a bomb and took away the informant's son. However,
even as per the First Information Report, there is no specific
overtact attributed to the present petitioner. Learned counsel for
the petitioner further submits that the victim boy after his recovery
in his statement under Section 164 Cr. P.C. has not named the
present petitioner.



Considering the aforementioned facts and circumstances and that the same stands supported by paragraph No. 53 of the case diary, let the petitioner above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Sessions Judge, Samastipur, in connection with Tajpur P.S. Case No. 237/2012.
