APP for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for the
offence punishable under Sections 272 and 273 of the Indian Penal
Code and Section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act,
2016.

18 litres of Nepali saufi wine is said to have been
recovered from the cycle of the petitioner and the petitioner was
apprehended.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner
that no incriminating article has been recovered from the
conscious physical possession of the petitioner. He has no concern



either with the seized liquor or with the cycle in question. He has been falsely implicated in the case at the instance of his enemies. He has no criminal antecedent. He has been languishing in custody since 18.02.2018.

Considering the facts aforesaid, the above named petitioner is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned 4th Addl. Sessions Judge cum Special Judge, Excise, Motihari in connection with Ghorasahan (Jharokhar) Case No. 64 of 2018.
