APP for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for the
offence punishable under Section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition
and Excise Act, 2016.

36 litres of Nepali wine is said to have been
recovered from the motorcycle and the petitioner who was driving
the same and pillion rider Vikki Kumar were apprehended.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner
that no incriminating article has been recovered from the
conscious physical possession of the petitioner. He has no concern
with the seized liquor. He had given lift to Vikki Kumar and had



no knowledge of carrying of liquor by him in the bag. He has been falsely implicated in the case by the police at the instance of his enemies. He has no criminal antecedent. He has been languishing in custody since 21.03.2018.

Considering the facts aforesaid, the above named petitioner is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Addl. Sessions Judge-IV cum Special Judge, Excise, East Champaran, Motihari in connection with Excise Case No. 140 of 2018.
