Heard learned counsel for the parties.

This is an appeal under Section 14(A)(2) of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 against the refusal of prayer for bail by the learned 1st Additional Sessions Judge-cum-Special Judge, West Champaran at Bettiah, in connection with Bettiah (Muffasil) Police Station Case No.334 of 2009 registered under Section 307/34 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 3(i)(x)(xv) of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989.

The appellant is neither named in the FIR nor assailant of the informant because name of co-accused Sunni Kumar surfaced in the confessional statement of Binay Kumar Sharma as assailant.



The appellant is in custody since 18.03.2016.

Considering the aforesaid fact, let the appellant, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.20,000/- (Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Court-below where the case is pending in connection with the aforesaid case, with condition that the appellant shall fully cooperate with the investigation/trial of the case, failing which the court below shall be at liberty to cancel the bail bond of the appellant.

Accordingly, the impugned order is set aside and appeal is allowed.
