ORAL ORDER

6 12-02-2018 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and

learned APP for the State.

Petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for the
offence punishable under Section 395 of the Indian Penal Code.

The FIR of the occurrence of dacoity is against
unknown. The petitioner was not identified during TI Parade nor
anything has been recovered from possession of the petitioner.

The inquiry report of the District Judge,
Samastipur would reveal that several sessions trial arising out of
the same case and arising out of different commitment orders are
pending in different court. The learned Sessions Judge, Samastipur
shall ensure that all the sessions trial be heard by the one court.

Considering the nature of allegation and nature of
material, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on



furnishing bail bond of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court below where the case is pending in connection with Ujiarpur Police Station Case No. 21 of 2002, subject to the condition that the petitioner shall fully cooperate with the investigation and trial of the case, failing which the court below shall be at liberty to cancel the bail bond of the petitioner.
