2 20-06-2018 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the

learned APP for the State.

Petitioner, already in custody, seeks bail in connection
with Teghra PS Case No.150 of 2018 registered under Sections
144, 366(A), 506 and 120(B)/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Allegation in brief is that the minor daughter of the
informant was kidnapped by the accused persons.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that it is
not a case of kidnapping rather of elopement as the daughter of
the informant eloped with one Pushpak Kumar and solemnized
marriage with him which is reflected from the statement of the
girl recorded under Section 164 Cr.P.C., moreover the girl is
major, 19 years of age and Pushpak Kumar has been granted
anticipatory bail.



Having considered the aforesaid facts and circumstances, petitioner Bittu Kumar is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned CJM, Begusarai in connection with Teghra PS Case No.150 of 2018.
