ORAL ORDER

2 19-06-2018 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned APP for the State.

Petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 364(A), 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

According to FIR, 15 unknown persons kidnapped to the son of the informant for ransom. On the very next day, the victim returned. Petitioner has stated on oath that the victim did not name the petitioner in his statement before the police. Only material is confessional statement of co-accused-Ramji Singh Kharwar. He further submits that similarly situated co-accused-Sugreev Kharwar has already been allowed bail by this Court vide Annexure-2.

Considering the aforesaid facts, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.20,000/- (Twenty Thousand) with two



sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court below where the case is pending in connection with Chutiya Police Station Case No.59 of 2017, subject to the condition that the petitioner shall fully cooperate with the investigation/trial of the case, failing which the court below shall be at liberty to cancel the bail bond of the petitioner.
