This application, for grant of anticipatory bail, arises out of Harnaut Police Station Case No. 344 of 2017, disclosing offences under Sections 290 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition Excise Act, 2016.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner, who is of clean antecedent, is innocent and has not committed any offence. In fact, the alleged recovery of foreign liquor was made from the Pick up Van in question, which is evident from seizure list and the petitioner has no concern with the alleged recovery. Nothing has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. Hence, the petitioner deserves the privilege of anticipatory bail.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case,



let the petitioner, above named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the Court below within six weeks, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned 6th Additional Sessions Judge- cum- Special Judge (Excise), Nalanda at Biharsharif, in connection with Harnaut Police Station Case No. 344 of 2017, subject to the condition laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
