2 06-06-2018 Heard learned Counsel for the petitioners and
learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

This application, for grant of anticipatory bail, arises
out of Nawanagar Police Station Case No. 37 of 2018, disclosing
offences under Sections 30(a) of Bihar Prohibition and Excise
Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that
the petitioners, who are of clean antecedent, are innocent and
have not committed any offence. In fact, the alleged recovery of
country-made liquor was made from the abandon land behind
the shop of Sahendra Sah, which is evident from seizure list and
the petitioners have no concern with the alleged recovery.
Nothing has been recovered from the conscious possession of
the petitioners. Hence, the petitioners deserve the privilege of



anticipatory bail.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, let the petitioners, above named, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the Court below within six weeks, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Additional Sessions Judge-2nd –cum- Special Judge, Excise Act, Buxar, in connection with Nawanagar Police Station Case No. 37 of 2018, subject to the condition laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
