The petitioner is in custody in connection with  
Kahalgaon P.S. Case No. 228 of 2018 for the offence under  
Sections 188, 290 of Indian Penal Code and 30 (a), 37 (c) of  
Bihar Excise Act, 2016.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that  
petitioner has no criminal antecedent. He submits that nothing
