2 21-06-2018 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for the
offence punishable under Section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition
and Excise Act, 2016.

Around 9 litres of foreign liquor is said to have been
recovered from the house of the petitioner and the petitioner
managed to escape.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner
that no incriminating article has been recovered from the
conscious physical possession of the petitioner. He has no concern
with the seized liquor. He has been falsely implicated in the case
at the instance of his enemies. The house of the petitioner is



inhabited by several family members and he had no knowledge of keeping of the said liquor in the house. He has no criminal antecedent. He has been languishing in custody since 18.04.2018.

Considering the facts aforesaid, the above named petitioner is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned 2nd A.D.J. cum Special Judge, Excise, Bhagalpur in connection with Sultanganj P.S. Case No. 76 of 2018.
