3 20-02-2018 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned APP for the State.

Petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for the offence punishable under Section 394 of the Indian Penal Code.

The FIR of the occurrence of robbery is against unknown.

The petitioner has stated on oath that he has got no criminal antecedent and he is in custody since 15.11.2017. However, has not been put on TI Parade nor anything has been recovered from his possession.

Considering the aforesaid facts, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court below where



the case is pending in connection with Daudpur Police Station Case No. 183 of 2017, subject to the condition that the petitioner shall fully cooperate with the investigation and trial of the case, failing which the court below shall be at liberty to cancel the bail bond of the petitioner.
