2 19-07-2018 Heard learned counsels for the petitioner and the

State.

Petitioner seeks bail in connection with Gaya Rail
P.S. Case No. 77 of 2018 registered for the offence punishable
under sections 3, 5 and 18 of the Mahua Flowers Act.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner
submits that petitioner has been made a victim of circumstances
in the present case. Nothing has been recovered from the
conscious possession of this petitioner. The alleged recovery is
from a bogie of train in which petitioner was travelling merely
as a passenger. Petitioner has no concern with the alleged
recovered items. Petitioner is a man of clean antecedent and is
in custody since 01.04.2018.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case



and the submissions advanced on behalf of the parties, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Special Judge, Excise Act, Gaya in connection with Gaya rail P.S. Case No. 77 of 2018.
