02 27-07-2018 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned APP
for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for the offence punishable under Section 30 (a) and 47 of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

14.400 liters of foreign liquor is said to have been recovered from the motorcycle and petitioner and one another accused, namely, Bimlesh Kumar sitting on the said motorcycle were apprehended.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that no incriminating article has been recovered from the conscious physical possession of the petitioner. He has no concern with the seized liquor. He has been falsely implicated in this case at the instance of his enemy by planting the aforesaid recovery from his



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possession. Though one more case under the Excise Act has been lodged against the petitioner but he is on bail in the said case. He has been languishing in custody since 28.05.2018.

In the facts and circumstances of the case, the above named petitioner is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Additional District and Sessions Judge-II-cum-Special Judge Excise, Rohtas, Sasaram in connection with Akodhigola P.S. Case No. 116 of 2018.
