2 03-08-2018 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

The petitioner is languishing in custody for the
offence punishable under Section 366A/34 of the Indian Penal
Code.

The FIR reveals the allegation of kidnapping of
the daughter of the informant with intent to marry with her. The
FIR further shows that the victim was seen by the villagers going
along with co-accused Prakash Thakur on a motorcycle.
Petitioner is father of Prakash Thakur. Co-accused Chhotu Thakur
and Renu Devi have already been allowed anticipatory bail by a
coordinate Bench of this Court in Cr. Misc. No.33697 of 2018.

Considering the fact that there is no direct



evidence against the petitioner, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.20,000/- (Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Court-below where the case is pending in connection with N.T.P.C. Khaira P.S. Case No.22 of 2018, with following conditions:

(a) Both the bailors shall be the resident of territorial jurisdiction of the learned Court-below.

(b) The petitioner shall fully cooperate with the investigation/trial of the case, failing which the court below shall be at liberty to cancel the bail bond of the petitioner.
