for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for the offence punishable under Sections 272 & 273 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 30 (a) (d) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

5 liters of country made liquor and some utensils and raw material and instruments meant for brewing country made liquor is said to have been recovered from the house of the petitioner and petitioner was apprehended.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that no incriminating article has been recovered from the conscious physical possession of the petitioner. She has no concern with the



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seized articles. The house of the petitioner is inhabited by her several family members and she had no knowledge of keeping of the said articles in the house. She has been falsely implicated in this case at the instance of her enemy. There is violation of Section 100 Cr.P.C. She happens to be lady and has no criminal antecedent and has been languishing in custody since 30.06.2018.

In the facts and circumstances of the case, the above named petitioner is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Special Judge Excise, Gaya in connection with Atri P.S. Case No.215 of 2018.
