2      10-01-2018              Earlier prayer for bail of the petitioner was rejected vide  
  
order dated 26.7.2017 passed in Cr.Misc.No.34271 of 2017 with  
  
an observation to renew his prayer for bail after framing of charge.

Submission of learned counsel for the petitioner is that  
  
charge has been framed and he is in custody for more than ten  
  
months and there is general and omnibus allegation. Further  
  
submission is that petitioner is ready to abide by any condition that  
  
may be imposed upon him if bail is granted.

Heard learned APP for the State.

In the facts and circumstances of the case, let petitioner,  
  
above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of  
  
Rs.25,000/- (Rupees twenty five thousand) with two sureties of the  
  
like amount each to the satisfaction of the 2<sup>nd</sup> Additional District



Judge, Bhojpur, Arrah, in connection with Sessions Trial No. 274 of 2017, arising out of Dhangai P.S.Case No. 07 of 2017, subject to the conditions that (1) one of the bailors shall be a local person having sufficient immoveable properties within the jurisdiction of court concerned and (2) he will co-operate in trial and appear in court as and when required, except on genuine ground, failing which his bail bond shall be cancelled.
