ORAL ORDER

2 13-02-2018 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and the counsel appearing on behalf of the State.

From Annexure-8 and 8/1, it appears that the petitioners have represented before the Vice-Chancellor, L.N.M. University for payment of UGC scale of pay for the period as mentioned in Annexure-8 and 8/1. The pay verification cell of the Government of Bihar in the Education Department has verified the entitlement of the petitioners yet the petitioners have not



been paid the benefit as fixed by the pay verification cell. The representation of the petitioners in this regard contained in Annexure 8 and 8/1 are pending.

Under the aforesaid circumstances, the Vice-Chancellor is directed to take final decision on the representation contained in Annexure-8 and 8/1 within a period of sixty days from the date of receipt/production of a copy of this order. The vice-Chancellor is also required to fix accountability on the erring officers for delay in payment of monetary benefit arising out of the pay fixation by verification cell of the State Government. The monetary benefit admissible to the petitioners must be paid within a maximum period of sixty days from the date of receipt/production of a copy of this order.

In the event of delay in making the payment, the University shall fix accountability on the erring officers and pay interest @ 9 per cent per annum from the date of accrual to the date of actual payment.

With the aforesaid, the writ application stands disposed of.
