ORAL ORDER

02 18-08-2018 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned APP for the State.

The petitioners seek bail in a case registered for the offence punishable under Sections 30 (g) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

60 kgs. of Mahua flower is said to have been recovered from the motorcycle of the petitioners and the petitioners were apprehended.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioners that no incriminating article has been recovered from the conscious physical possession of the petitioners. They have no concern with the seized article. They have been falsely implicated in this case by the police merely on suspicion while they were passing through



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the place of occurrence at the time of occurrence and the real culprit managed to escape dumping the aforesaid article there seeing the police personnel. They have no criminal antecedent and have been languishing in custody since 01.07.2018.

In the facts and circumstances of the case, the above named petitioners are directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Special Judge Excise, Gaya, District- Gaya in connection with Barachatti P.S. Case No. 431 of 2018.
