Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned

APP for the State.

This is a case registered under Sections 414/34 of the
Indian Penal Code and 25(1-b)a, 26 and 35 of the Arms Act.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner
having no criminal antecedent has falsely been implicated in this
case. He denies and disputes the alleged recovery of a loaded
country made pistol and four cartridges from his possession.
Petitioner is in jail custody since 08.08.2017.

In the facts and circumstances of the case, prayer for
bail of the petitioner is allowed. Let the petitioner above named be
released on bail on his furnishing bonds of Rs 10,000/- (Rupees
Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the



satisfaction of **Chief Judicial Magistrate, Gaya** in **Sherghati (Dobhi) P.S. Case No. 430 of 2017** subject to the conditions :

- (i) That one of the bailors will be a close relative of the Petitioner who will give an affidavit giving genealogy as to how he is related with the Petitioner. The bailor will also undertake to inform the Court if there is any change in the address of the Petitioner.
- (ii) That the Petitioner will be well represented on each date and if he fails to do so on two consecutive dates, his bail will be liable to be cancelled.
