Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned counsel
appearing on behalf of the State.

Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to
withdraw the writ petition in order to enable the petitioner to
approach the respondent-authorities for redressal of his grievances
with regard to payment of salary from March, 2008 to 22nd of
January, 2015.

In view of the fact that the earlier writ petition filed by the
petitioner being CWJC No. 14479 of 2010 was allowed by this
Court vide order dated 09.01.2015, as a matter of corollary, the
petitioner is entitled to payment of salary for the aforesaid period.



Thus, without expressing any opinion on the merit of the claim of the petitioner, the writ petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to file representation before the respondent Nos. 4 and 5, who shall examine the case of the petitioner and decide the same in the light of the decision of this Court dated 09.01.2015 and pass reasoned order within a period of 60 days from the date of receipt/production of a copy of this order.
