The petitioner is in custody since 20.07.2018 in  
connection with Araria P.S. Case No.473 of 2018 and Special  
Case No.827/18 registered for the offence under Sections  
30(a)/36/37(2)/38 of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise  
(Amendment) Act, 2016.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the  
alleged recovery was not made from the conscious possession  
of the petitioner but from the place known as “Mushari in Jai  
Prakash Nagar”. It is further submitted that the petitioner has no  
criminal antecedent.

Considering the aforementioned facts and  
circumstances, let the petitioner, above named, be released on



bail on his furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Additional District Judge, Araria, in connection with Araria P.S. Case No.473 of 2018, Special Case No.827/18.
