2 30-08-2018 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned APP
for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for the offence punishable under Sections 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

10.80 liters of foreign liquor is said to have been recovered from the possession of the petitioner and the petitioner was apprehended.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that no incriminating article has been recovered from conscious physical possession of the petitioner. He has no concern with the seized liquor. He has been falsely implicated in this case at the instance of his enemy by planting the aforesaid recovery from his



possession. Though one more case under Excise Act has been lodged against the petitioner, but he is on bail in the said case. He has no criminal antecedent and has been languishing in custody since 27.07.2018.

In the facts and circumstances of the case, the above named petitioner is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned ADJ-VI-cum-Special Judge Excise, Samastipur in connection with Excise Case No. 220 of 2018.
