2 20-09-2018 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and the
counsel appearing on behalf of the State.

Petitioners are in custody in connection Special Case
No. 6221 of 2018 arising out of Patna Junction Rail P.S. Case
No. 222 of 2018 for the offence under sections 20, 22, 29
NDPS Act and 30(a) of the Bihar Excise Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that
petitioners have no criminal antecedent and no contraband was
recovered from the possession of the petitioners and levelling
Sections 20, 22 and 29 of the NDPS Act is uncalled for.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that
petitioners are in custody since 5.7.2018.

Considering the aforesaid fact that petitioners have no



criminal antecedent and they have remained in custody for more than two months, let the petitioners, named above, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Special Judge Excise Act, Patna, in connection with Special Case No. 6221 of 2018, arising out of Patna Junction Rail P.S. Case No. 222 of 2018.
