2 18-01-2018 Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the

learned APP for the State.

The petitioner seeks regular bail in connection with
Katoriya P.S. Case No. 199 of 2017 for the offences punishable
under Sections 30(d) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act,
2016 and section 3 of Mahua Flower Rule.

The allegation is regarding recovery of 30 kg of
Mahua flower from the motorcycle driven by the petitioner herein.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that
the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case. It is
further submitted that the petitioner has a clean antecedent and he
is in custody since 16.11.2017.

Considering the nature of accusation, the period of



custody already undergone and the fact that the petitioner has a clean antecedent, the petitioner, above named, is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Additional Sessions Judge-I1, Banka in connection with Katoriya P.S.Case No. 199 of 2017.
