ORAL ORDER

2 28-09-2018 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the State.

The petitioner is in custody in connection with Jaynagar
P.S.Case No.332 of 2018 registered for an offence under Sections
272 and 273/34 of the IPC and Section 30(a) of the Bihar
Prohibition & Excise Act, 2016.

As per FIR, the informant apprehended this petitioner after
chase near Nepal border and recovered Nepali wine from his
possession.

It has been submitted that nothing has been recovered from
the possession of the petitioner and he was arrested merely on
suspicion. Petitioner is in custody since 22.06.2018 having clean
antecedent.

The learned APP opposed the submissions.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances,



prayer for bail is allowed. Let the above named petitioner be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Additional District & Sessions Judge-2nd -cum-Special Judge, Excise Act, Madhubani in connection with Jay Nagar P.S.Case No.332 of 2018 (GR No.871 of 2018) with following conditions:-

- (i) One of the bailors of the petitioner shall be a local person having sufficient immovable property within the jurisdiction of the concerned Court.
- (ii) The petitioner will not induce any witness or tamper with the evidence.
- (iii) The petitioner shall cooperate in the disposal of trial and make themselves available as and when required by the court and on the event of failure on his part to appear before the court below on two consecutive dates without showing any genuine reasons, the prosecution is free to move for cancellation of his bail.
