4 22-03-2018 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and
learned APP for the State.

Petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 304(B), 201/34 of the Indian Penal Code and 3/4 of Dowry Prohibition Act.

There is general and omnibus allegation of demand of dowry and torture for the same. Husband is already in custody and the petitioner is father-in-law, and elder brother-in-law of the victim. Petitioners are in custody since 20.07.2017. Mother-in-law has already been allowed anticipatory bail by a Coordinate Bench of this Court in Cr.Misc No.56300 of 2017.

Considering the aforesaid facts especially the general and omnibus nature of allegation, let the petitioners,



above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.20,000/- (Twenty Thousand)each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court below where the case is pending in connection with Jagdishpur Police Station Case No.176 of 2017, subject to the condition that the petitioners shall fully cooperate with the trial of the case, failing which the court below shall be at liberty to cancel the bail bond of the petitioners.
