2 01-11-2018 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Section 147,148,149,447,448,341,342,323,307,302,354 and 379 of the Indian Penal Code.

Co-accused-Kausal Kumar Chaudhary @Mannu Chaudhary has been allowed anticipatory bail by a Coordinate Bench of this Court vide Annexure-2, considering the facts that in the FIR there is specific allegation against co-accused-Veeru Chaudhary and Rajiv Chaudhary to have assaulted the deceased with iron rod .

Considering the aforesaid fact, let the



petitioner, above named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of thirty days from the date of receipt of the order, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.20,000 (Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned court below where the case is pending in connection with Ashok Paper Mill P.S.Case No.18 of 2018, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure and further the petitioner shall fully cooperate with the investigation/trial of the case, failing which the court below shall be at liberty to cancel the bail bond of the petitioner.
