2 20-09-2018 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

The petitioner is languishing in custody for the offences punishable under Sections 272/273 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 30/30(a)/38/41 of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

Submission is that petitioner is neither driver nor cleaner nor owner of the truck.

Considering the aforesaid fact, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail **after completion of three months of custody** on furnishing bail bond of Rs.20,000/- (Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Court-below where the case is



pending in connection with Masrakh P.S. Case No.267 of 2018,
with following conditions:

(a) Both the bailors shall be the resident of territorial
jurisdiction of the learned Court-below.

(b) The petitioner shall fully cooperate with the
investigation/trial of the case, failing which the court below shall
be at liberty to cancel the bail bond of the petitioner.
