2 06-10-2018 I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the

State.

The petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for offences punishable under Section 30 (a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

It is contended that, as per allegation, 40 litres of country-made liquor was recovered from the possession of the petitioner. Petitioner claims that she is having clean antecedent and is in custody since 17.08.2018.

Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, the above named petitioner is directed to be released on bail on her furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/-(Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Special Judge, Excise Act, Gaya, in connection



with Gaya Rail P.S. Case No. 265 of 2018.

If the petitioner, after her release in this case, is again found involved in similar nature of cases then the concerned court would be at liberty to take steps for cancellation of her bail bonds.
