ORAL ORDER

2 06-10-2018 As prayed, learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to make necessary correction in paragraph 11 of the Bail Petition.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for offence punishable under Section 30 (a) of Bihar Excise Amendment Act.

It is contended that, as per allegation, 5 liters of Mahua liquor was recovered from the house of the petitioner. It is contended that nothing has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. It is urged that the petitioner is in custody since 17.08.2018. It is claimed that his antecedent is clean.



Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, the petitioner, above-named, is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/-(Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Additional Sessions Judge-VI-cum-Special Judge, Excise Act, Samastipur in connection with Excise Case No. 243 of 2018 with a condition that if the petitioner, after his release in this case, is again found involved in similar nature of cases then the concerned court would be at liberty to take steps for cancellation of his bail bonds.
