Heard learned counsel for the petitioner.

Petitioner prays for bail in connection with Darbhanga
Rail P.S.Case No. 131 of 2018 registered for the offences
punishable under Sections 328 and 379 of the Indian Penal Code.

Allegation as per FIR is that he supplied tea to the
informant and his wife in train and took away their belongings.

Submission of learned counsel for the petitioner is that he
is not named in the FIR and nothing has been recovered from his
possession and he is in custody since 27.6.2018.

Heard learned APP also, who has opposed the prayer for
bail stating that offence is very serious and he is accused in one
more case of similar type.

Having heard both sides and in the facts and



circumstances, as stated above, I am not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner at this stage.

However, once charge has been framed and trial is commenced, learned trial court shall release the petitioner on bail to its own satisfaction on the condition that he has to co-operate in disposal of trial.

With the above observation, this application is disposed of.
