APP for the State.

Petitioner seeks bail in **Khajkala P.S. Case No.115 of 2018** instituted for the offence under Section(s) 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner has got no criminal antecedents.

It is alleged that 59 litres illicit liquor was recovered from jute bag buried in the ground. The seizure list is the part of the First Information Report, in which it is mentioned that seizure has been made from the land adjacent to Baba Mandir.

Petitioner is said to be in custody since 08.05.2018.

In the facts and circumstances of the case, prayer of



the petitioner for grant of bail is allowed. Let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the **Special Judge, Excise, Patna**, in connection with **Khajkala P.S. Case No.115 of 2018**, subject to the condition that both the bailors shall be close relative of the petitioner.
