2 12-10-2018 Heard learned counsel for petitioners and learned A.P.P.
for the State.

Petitioners seek bail in Majhauria P.S. Case No.
38/2018, registered for the offences punishable under Section
304(B) and 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Allegation is committing murder of informant's
daughter on account of non-fulfillment of demand of dowry.

It has been submitted that petitioners are mother-in-law
and father-in-law. They have falsely been implicated in this case.
They are living separately and have no concern with the family
affairs of the deceased.

Petitioners have no criminal antecedent. They are in
custody since 28.06.2018 and 18.06.2018 respectively.



Considering the facts aforesaid, the petitioners above-named, are directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of District & Sessions Judge, West Champaran, Bettiah in connection with Majhaulia P.S. Case No. 38/2018, subject to the conditions:

- (1.) Bailors should be local having sufficient immovable property within the jurisdiction of the court concerned.
- (2.) Petitioners shall co-operate in the trial and shall be present on each and every date fixed by the court and their absence on two consecutive dates without proper and reasonable reason will be sufficient to cancel their bail bonds.
- (3.) If the petitioners tamper with the evidence or the witnesses of the case, in that case, prosecution will be at liberty to move for cancellation of bail of the petitioners.
