2 29-10-2018 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
A.P.P. for the State.

Petitioner seeks bail in Keoti P.S. Case No. 32/2018,
registered for the offences punishable under Sections 304(B), 201
and 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Allegation is committing murder of the informant's
daughter on account of non-fulfillment of demand of dowry by her
husband and in-laws.

It has been submitted that petitioner has falsely been
implicated in this case. Petitioner is father-in-law of the deceased.
Deceased died due to burn injury received while preparing food.
Co-accused Shiv Kumari Devi who is mother-in-law of the
deceased has been granted bail by a coordinate bench of this court



vide order dated 13.09.2018 passed in Cr. Misc. 49324/2018.

Petitioner has no criminal antecedent. He is in custody since 31.05.2018.

Considering the facts aforesaid, the petitioner above-named, is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate VII, Darbhanga in connection with Keoti P.S. Case No. 32/2018, subject to the conditions:

- (1.) Bailors should be local having sufficient immovable property within the jurisdiction of the court concerned.
- (2.) Petitioner shall co-operate in the trial and shall be properly represented on each and every date fixed by the court.
- (3.) If the petitioner tampers with the evidence or the witnesses of the case, in that case, prosecution will be at liberty to move for cancellation of bail of the petitioner.
