learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in Barhat P.S. Case No.
33/2018, instituted for the offences under Sections 366(a), 34 and
504 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted
that victim girl after recovery has given her statement under
Section 164 Cr.P.C., which is annexed as annexure-2, wherein she
has stated that she had voluntarily gone with this petitioner to
Bangalore. She was not taken forcibly by anybody.

Considering the aforesaid fact and circumstances,
prayer of the petitioner for grant of bail is allowed. Let the
petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail



bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Jamui in connection with Barhat P.S. Case No. 33/2018, subject to the conditions that both the bailors shall be the close relative of the petitioner.
