ORAL ORDER

2 10-10-2018 Earlier prayer for bail of the petitioner was rejected by this Court vide order dated 18.9.2017 passed in Cr.Misc.No. 42707 of 2017 and petitioner was given liberty to renew his prayer for bail if trial was not concluded within a period of nine months.

Submission of learned counsel for the petitioner is that petitioner is in custody since 24.10.2016 and from perusal of record it appears that the girl was major and was consenting party and trial is pending for evidence.

Heard learned APP also.

Having heard both sides and in the facts and circumstances and also considering the period of custody, let the petitioner, named above, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees twenty five thousand) with two



sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Additional Sessions Judge-cum-FTC-VII, Aurangabad, in connection with Sessions Trial No. 229 of 2017, arising out of Nabinagar P.S.Case No. 172 of 2016, subject to the condition that one of the bailors shall be a family member of the petitioner having sufficient immoveable properties within the jurisdiction of court concerned and further condition is that petitioner has to co-operate in disposal of trial and appear in court as and when required, otherwise his bail bond shall be cancelled.
