ORAL ORDER

2 11-10-2018 Heard the parties.

The petitioner seeks regular bail in connection with Samastipur (Town) P.S.Case no.142 of 2018 dated 18.5.2018 registered for offences punishable under Sections 411, 413 and 414/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Allegation against the petitioner as per FIR is that the police apprehended one accused and only at his instance 12 stolen motorcycles were recovered and one motorcycle was recovered from the house of the petitioner.

Submission of the learned counsel for the petitioner is that he has no criminal antecedent and he has purchased the motorcycle from the co-accused. He is in custody for five months.



The Charge sheet has been submitted.

Heard learned A.P.P. also.

Having heard both sides and in view of the facts and circumstances, as stated above, let the petitioner, above named, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of CJM, Samastipur in connection with Samastipur (Town) P.S.Cas enO.142 of 2018 dated 18.5.2018.

With following conditions :

- (i) One of the bailors of the petitioner shall be a local person having sufficient immovable property within the jurisdiction of the concerned court.
- (ii) The petitioner will not induce any witness or tamper with the evidence.
- (iii) The petitioner shall co-operate in the disposal of trial and make himself available as and when required by the court and in the event of failure to appear before the court below on two consecutive dates without showing any genuine reasons, the prosecution is free to move for cancellation of his bail bond.

With the aforesaid observation, this application is allowed.
