2 13-12-2018 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the
learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection
with Jadopur P.S. Case No. 44 of 2018 registered under Sections
363, 366A/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner
submits that petitioner is innocent. The victim, in her statement
recorded under section 164 Cr. P.C. (Annexure-2), clearly stated
that she used to love with the petitioner and voluntarily, left her
house. Further submission is that the victim was medically
examined and her age was assessed 17-18 years (Anneuxre-3).

Having considered the facts and circumstances of the
case, let the above named petitioner be released on bail, in the
event of arrest or surrender before the learned Court below



within a period of four weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the J.M., 1st Class, Gopalganj in connection with Jadopur P.S. Case No. 44 o 2018, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr. P.C.
