**ORAL ORDER**

2      06-11-2018      Heard the parties.

The petitioner seeks regular bail in connection with Chauthyam P.S.Case No.68 of 2018 dated 14.4.2018 G.R.NO.955 of 2018 registered for offences punishable under Sections 341, 323, 447, 448, 307, 325, 354, 379, 504, 506/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Allegation against the petitioner is of firing on the informant causing injury to him.

Submission of the learned counsel for the petitioner is that he has annexed the injury report as Annexure 2 series and no fire arm injury was found on the person of the injured and others rather all the injuries were of hard and blunt substance and they are simple in nature.



Heard learned A.P.P. also.

Having heard both sides and in view of the facts and circumstances, as stated above, let the petitioner, above named, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned CJM, Khagaria in connection with Chautham P.S.Case no.68 of 2018 dated 14.4.2018 G.R.No.955 of 2018.

With following conditions :

- (i) One of the bailors of the petitioner shall be a local person having sufficient immovable property within the jurisdiction of the concerned court.
- (ii) The petitioner will not induce any witness or tamper with the evidence.
- (iii) The petitioner shall co-operate in the disposal of trial and make himself available as and when required by the court and in the event of failure to appear before the court below on two consecutive dates without showing any genuine reasons, the prosecution is free to move for cancellation of his bail bond.

With the aforesaid observation, this application is allowed.
