ORAL ORDER

2 30-11-2018 Heard the parties.

The petitioner seeks regular bail in connection with Jamui P.S.Case no.395/18 registered for offences punishable under Sections 366A/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Petitioner is not named in the FIR and there is allegation of kidnapping of the minor daughter of the informant.

Submission of the learned counsel for the petitioner is that he has been made accused only on the basis of suspicion and later on statement of the girl has been recorded, in which she has not supported the prosecution case and in support of that photocopy of the statement of the girl has been filed. The petitioner is in custody since 31.7.2018.

Heard learned A.P.P. also.



Having heard both sides and in view of the facts and circumstances, as stated above, let the petitioner, above named, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned CJM, Jamui in connection with Jamui P.S.Case no.395/18..

With following conditions :

- (i) One of the bailors of the petitioner shall be a local person having sufficient immovable property within the jurisdiction of the concerned court.
- (ii) The petitioner will not induce any witness or tamper with the evidence.
- (iii) The petitioner shall co-operate in the disposal of trial and make himself available as and when required by the court and in the event of failure to appear before the court below on two consecutive dates without showing any genuine reasons, the prosecution is free to move for cancellation of his bail bond.

With the aforesaid observation, this application is allowed.
