Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Petitioner seeks bail in **Naubatpur P.S. Case No. 605 of 2015** registered for the offence punishable under Sections 498A, 304B/34 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 3/4 of Dowry Prohibition Act.

Allegation against the petitioner is of torturing the complainant for non fulfillment of demand of dowry along with FIR named accused.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that the petitioner is Devar and has been falsely implicated in this case. Similarly, situated co-accused person has been granted bail by a co-ordinate bench of this Court vide order dated 01.10.2018 in Criminal Miscellaneous No. 54581 of 2018. Petitioner has got no criminal antecedent and is in custody since



10.07.2018.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, let the petitioner named above be released on bail upon furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned **Chief Judicial Magistrate-II, Danapur, Patna**, in connection with **Naubatpur P.S. Case No. 605 of 2015**, with following conditions:-

(1) Bailors should be local having sufficient immovable property within the jurisdiction of the court concerned.

(2) Petitioner shall co-operate in the trial and shall be represented on each and every date fixed by the court.

(3) If the petitioner tampers with the evidence or the witnesses of the case, in that case, prosecution will be at liberty to move for cancellation of bail of the petitioner.
