2 22-11-2018 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as
learned Addl. Public Prosecutor for the State.

Petitioner seeks bail in a case registered under
Sections 379, 411, 413 and 414 of the IPC.

According to prosecution case itself, petitioner runs a
motor garage and three motorcycles were recovered from the
garage of the petitioner however, petitioner claims that out of
abovesaid three motorcycles, two belonged to petitioner whereas,
third motorcycle belongs to one Mina Devi, who had sent the said
motorcycle to the garage of the petitioner for repairing work.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case
and also taking note of the fact that petitioner does not have any



criminal antecedent, let the petitioner be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Bhagalpur in Kotwali (Tilkamanjhi) P.S. Case No. 471 of 2018.
