ORAL ORDER

2 26-11-2018 Heard the parties.

The petitioner seeks regular bail in connection with Jakkanpur P.S.Case no.324 of 2017 registered for offences punishable under Sections 392 the Indian Penal Code.

Allegation against the petitioner is that some miscreants have looted away his bag containing Rs.1,12,100/- and the key of the motorcycle. The petitioner is not named in the FIR.

Submission of the learned counsel for the petitioner is that he has been named only on disclosure made by the spy and though he is accused in five other cases but he is on bail in all those cases. He is in custody since 26.5.2018 and he has not been put on TIP. Now the charge sheet has also been submitted.

Heard learned A.P.P. also.



Having heard both sides and in view of the facts and circumstances, as stated above, let the petitioner, above named, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned ACJM Ist, Patna in connection with Jakkanpur P.S. Case No.324 of 2017..

With following conditions :

(i) One of the bailors of the petitioner shall be a local person having sufficient immovable property within the jurisdiction of the concerned court.

(ii) The petitioner will not induce any witness or tamper with the evidence.

(iii) The petitioner shall co-operate in the disposal of trial and make himself available as and when required by the court and in the event of failure to appear before the court below on two consecutive dates without showing any genuine reasons, the prosecution is free to move for cancellation of his bail bond.

With the aforesaid observation, this application is allowed.
