Petitioner seeks bail in **Goh P.S. Case No.182 of 2018** instituted for the offence under Section(s) 414 Indian Penal Code.

It is alleged that on confidential information the informant committed raid in the house of this petitioner and recovered one Apache motorcycle.

Counsel for petitioner submits that petitioner has no criminal antecedents. The house is a joint property and the petitioner has no knowledge about the aforesaid motorcycle.

Petitioner is in custody since 22.08.2018.

In the facts and circumstances of the case, prayer of the petitioner for grant of bail is allowed. Let the petitioner,



above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the **Sub-Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Daudnagar, Aurangabad**, in connection with **Goh P.S. Case No.182 of 2018**, subject to the condition that both the bailors shall be close relative of the petitioner.
