Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Petitioner seeks bail in **Bihiya P.S. Case No. 320 of 2018** registered for the offence punishable under Sections **302/201/120B/34** of the Indian Penal Code.

Allegation against the petitioner is of killing nephew of the Informant though he is not named in the FIR. FIR is against unknown.

It has been further submitted that petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case on the statement of Gudiya Devi with whom petitioner had quarrel about the prostitution business being run by said Gudiya Devi. Petitioner has got no criminal antecedent and is in custody since 25.08.2018.



Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, let the petitioner named above be released on bail upon furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned **5th ACJM, Bhojpur at Ara**, in connection with **Bihiya P.S. Case No. 320 of 2018**, with following conditions:-

(1) Bailors should be local having sufficient immovable property within the jurisdiction of the court concerned.

(2) Petitioner shall co-operate in the trial and shall be represented on each and every date fixed by the court.

(3) If the petitioner tampers with the evidence or the witnesses of the case, in that case, prosecution will be at liberty to move for cancellation of bail of the petitioner.
