2 17-12-2018 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned APP
for the State.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case registered under Sections 147, 148, 149, 341, 323, 332, 353, 307 of the Indian Penal Code.

The prosecution case, in brief, is that the informant received information that FIR named accused including the petitioner and unknown persons having forming unlawful assembly, blocked N.H. 31 and they are pelting stones on police and in due course, driver of the SDPO received head injury and due to which, NH 31 remained blocked for three hours and in consequence thereof, police vehicle was also damaged.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that the petitioner has got no criminal antecedent. There is no allegation



of tampering of witnesses alleged against the petitioner. General and omnibus allegation has been made against the petitioner. No specific overt act has been attributed to the petitioner. Altogether 14 persons are named in the FIR. The petitioner is not named in the FIR. The nature of injury is said to be simple.

On behalf of the State, it is submitted that the petitioner is not named in the Complaint Case/F.I.R.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, let the petitioner, above named, in the event of arrest/surrender before the learned court below within a period of six weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Begusarai in connection with Ballia P.S. Case No. 06 of 2018 subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
